International Awards for Undergraduates—EU

One of the most important cornerstones of Christ's Admissions strategy is the **promotion of diversity**; we believe that our students learn more, and learn better, if they are stretched and challenged by views and experiences unlike their own.

To this end, our Admissions team have worked hard to build links with various European countries; links that will be threatened with the decision by the UK government that, from October 2021 entry, EU students will no longer be eligible for home student fees, or tuition fee loans.

It is for this reason we are working to expand our International Awards for Undergraduates, offering bursaries of £10,000 annually, as well as a full or partial waiver of the College fee (£9,400), to ensure that we continue to attract the best and brightest students from Europe.
